Heavy Lift Operations at Cork Dockyard Loading "UHL Future"


This notice should be read in conjunction with:

Please note that from Monday 7th of December 2020 heavy lift operations are planned at Cork Dockyard loading project cargo onto the vessel '**UHL Future**'. These operations will occur at multiple times per day, for periods of up to 2-3 hours per lift. These operations are planned to be completed within 5 days.

During the lifting operations, commercial vessel traffic may be restricted from navigating in the vicinity of Cork Dockyard to facilitate safe operations. Vessels navigating in the area must contact Port Operations on VHF Channel 12 for details of any lifting operations, and associated navigation restrictions.

Vessel Masters & operators are requested to pass UHL Future at a minimum safe speed and producing no visible wash for the duration of the UHL Future's stay at Cork Dockyard. Vessels are further requested to keep a sharp lookout and to closely monitor VHF Channel 12 at all times for information updates.
