## Passage plans (for commercial vessels)

For the specific attention of vessel agents, vessel Masters and bridge teams.

Mariners are advised that standard passage plans are now available on the Port of Cork Company website at <u>www.portofcork.ie/passageplans/</u>. These passage plans cover routes to and from pilot stations and specific berth areas within Cork Harbour.

Furthermore, these standard passage plans are to assist Ship Masters and their bridge teams to prepare the vessel's own passage plans in line with their statutory obligations for berth to berth planning and specifically for the vessel's arrival / departure in Cork Harbour (Requirements under IMO resolution 893 and as adopted by relevant flag states, Port State Control and local regulations).

The list is not exhaustive and some modifications may apply depending on the prevailing circumstances (weather, traffic etc).
