NOTICE TO MARINERS

NO. 8 OF 2023

Cobh to Blackrock Race

This notice should be read in conjunction with:

• Chart 1777 / 1773

Mariners are advised that on Saturday 9th September 2023, a race will take place involving about 50 sailing vessels ranging in length overall from approximately 4 metres to 15 metres.

The first boats will start at approximately 1230 hrs along Cobh Roads, and may extend eastwards as far as the Bar Turn (adjacent to the Spit Lighthouse). All boats are expected to finish at 1400-1430 hrs at Blackrock Castle.

Vessels are requested to navigate with caution and with due regard for the occupants of the sailing craft and to minimise the effect of wash from their vessels.

On completion of the race, most vessels will return down river to their respective moorings, and must keep clear of commercial shipping.

Safety boats will accompany the race craft and will communicate on VHF Channel 69. Channel 16 will be used for emergencies.

The Safety Coordinator will monitor VHF Ch 12 for up to date information on commercial traffic movements and will advise the safety boats accordingly.
