

NOTICE TO MARINERS

NO. 3 OF 2024

Maintenance Dredging Campaign 2024

This notice should be read in conjunction with:

- Charts 1777 / 1773

Mariners are advised that on or after 1st of March 2024, a maintenance dredging campaign will commence within the jurisdiction of the Port of Cork Company and shall occur in all main navigation channels and berths.

The dredging project will be undertaken by three vessels:

- **TSHD Tristão Da Cunha** – Trailing Suction Hopper Dredger
- **Jenny D** – Bed Leveller / General Support
- **Barnacle** – Survey Vessel (an alternative may be used and is to be confirmed)

See images overleaf of vessels for reference.

The approximate dredging programme is as follows:

Mobilisation of Survey Vessel Barnacle 23rd February 2024

Mobilisation of Dredger and Support vessels Jenny D 29th February 2024

Commence Dredging 01st March 2024

The campaign is expected to be completed before the 11th of May 2024

Operations will continue 24-hours per day. When engaged in dredging, the vessels will display the lights and shapes required by Rule 27 of the International Rules for Prevention of Collisions at Sea (COLREG).

Mariners are requested to navigate with caution when in the vicinity of the above craft, to pass by as wide a margin as possible and proceed with minimum wash / speed. Navigation buoyage may be removed during the dredging campaign period and 'Cork Harbour Radio' should be called on VHF Ch 12 to confirm any buoy movements.

Port Operations and the above vessels may be contacted on VHF channel 12 to obtain further details pertaining to the dredging operations for the duration of the campaign.
