NOTICE TO MARINERS

No. 10 of 2025

Cobh Jailbreak Triathlon

This notice should be read in conjunction with:

Mariners are advised that a triathlon event will take place on the **Sunday 31**st **of August 2025** with a route between Spike Island, Cobh and its environs.

The swimming component will be in the waters between Spike Island and Cobh, specifically from the beach to the east of Spike Island Pier to Cobh Department of Defence Pier /Columbine Quay. The swimming element will form the first part of the event, with approximately 350 competitors participating.

The race route is on the map on page 2 of this notice.

Event schedule is as follows:

Safety Craft assemble on the route from Spike Island Pier to Cobh Department of Defence Pier / Columbine Quay	0930 hrs
Swimmers enter water and race commences (at Spike Island Pier / Beach)	1015 hrs
All Swimmers clear of the water (Cobh: Dept of Defence Pier / Columbine Quay & slipway) with marine element completed	1130 hrs

The swimmers will be supported by safety boats and sea-kayaks.

Mariners should keep well clear of the swimmers, reduce boat wash to a minimum when operating in the vicinity and obey the instructions of the safety craft.

Mariners are advised and requested not to cross the swimming route for the duration of the event.

The safety boats will maintain a listening watch on VHF channel 12 and 68 for the duration of the event.




Chart 1777 (extract)
