## **NOTICE TO MARINERS**

## NO. 14 OF 2025

## Diving and Maintenance Operations at Tivoli Berths

This notice should be read in conjunction with:

• Chart 1773

Mariners are advised that from the 17<sup>th</sup> of November2025 diving and maintenance operations will commence from the water on the berths at Tivoli. The areas affected are indicted on the image and chart extract below. The work will be conducted in stages and move from one portion of the berths to the next.

The operations are to continue until the end of September 2026.

Supporting the operations will be a number of craft including Pontoons and Safety boats.

Operations will be supported from the shore and this may include cranes and other equipment working over the quay edges.

When divers are in the water, the Alpha (A) flag will be displayed and the dive team will monitor VHF channel 12. Port Operations will be notified on each day of the intended area of operation at the berth.


Mariners are requested to pass the operations at a safe speed and by as wide a margin as practicable and navigate with due regard to good seamanship.


