Tivoli Container Crane Maintenance

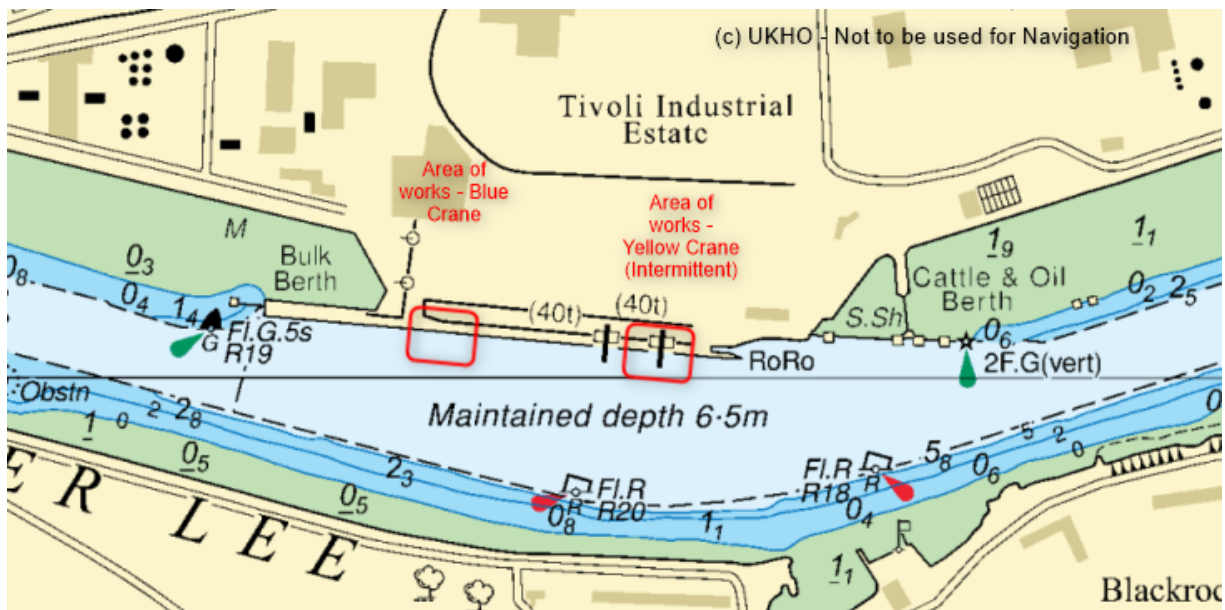
This notice should be read in conjunction with:

Mariners are advised that from **Sunday the 5th of July 2026** maintenance shall be carried out on the Ship-to-Shore (STS) Cranes at Tivoli Container Terminal. This will be for the period of July and August 2026

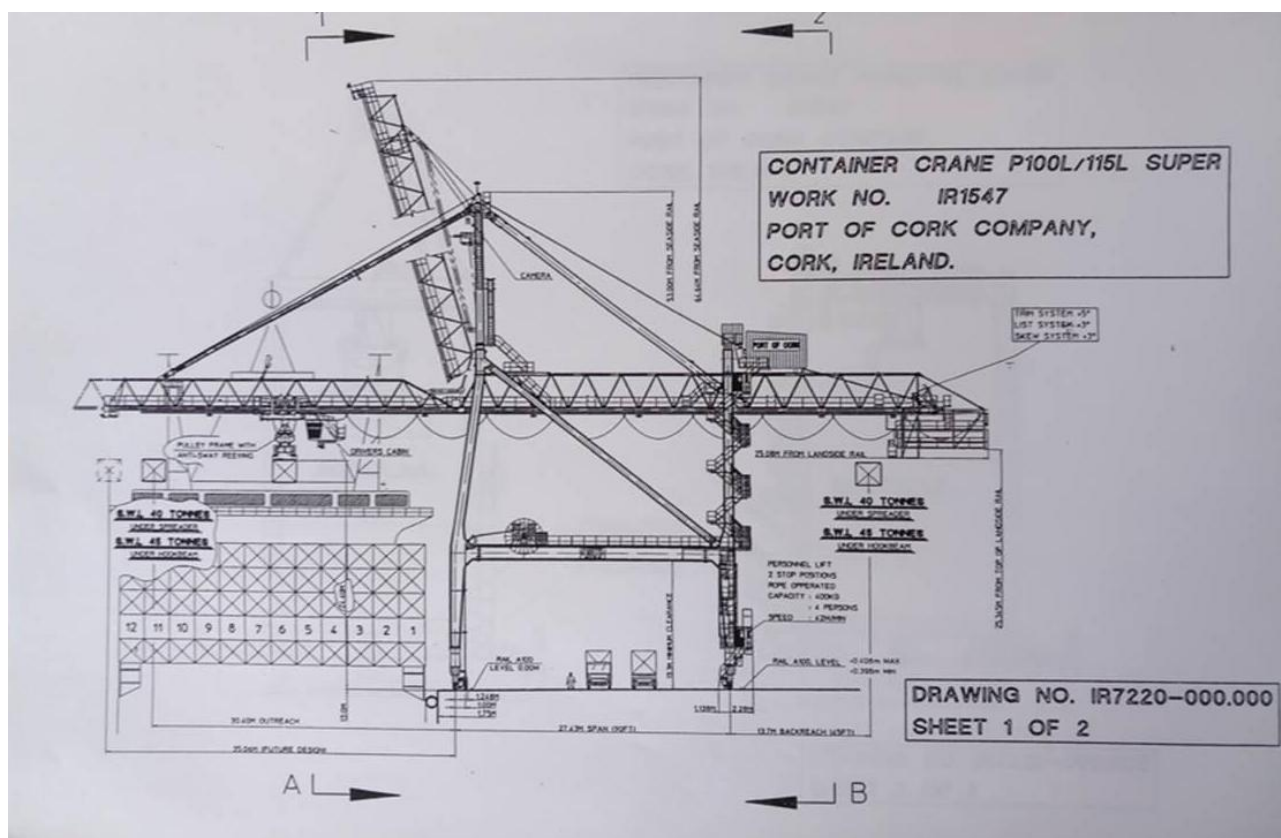
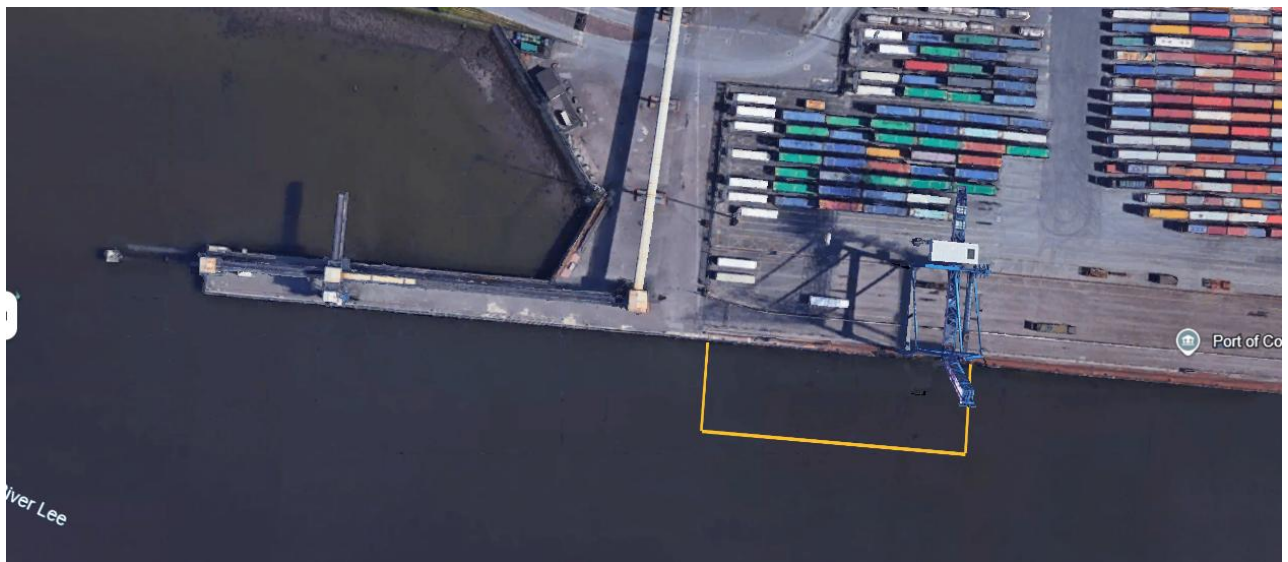
The main works will be to the Blue / Western Crane, which will be in a parked position as far west as is practicable with the boom down. In August, it will be possible to retract the boom with notice.

The Yellow / Eastern Crane will also be worked when there are no container vessel operations. The crane boom will be lowered as required to facilitation



- Always keep well clear of the STS cranes
- Be aware of potential obstructions and hanging cables from the cranes. Markers may be deployed to highlight risks as appropriate
- Navigate with extreme caution when passing the terminal.
- Do not pass beneath any crane boom under any circumstances.

All river users are requested to exercise due care and attention and to comply with this Notice for the safety of personnel and navigation.
